2016 is rapidly coming to a close. Fall harvest is wrapping up, spring-born calves are being weaned, and the cows are coming in from outlying pastures for the winter. It's that time of year when we look back and learn by celebrating our successes and analyze the failures. My goal is to have more successes

than failures. Although some years it's hard to evaluate or tell them apart.

We have owned Belted Galloway Cattle since 1993. We started small with one bred heifer. Over the course of 23 years, our herd has grown to nearly 30 breeding females. We have kept some of our replacements and purchased a select number of bulls and females from different breeders around the USA. We enjoy tremendously, attending many gatherings and events. Examples include sales like the Belted Galloway Premium Sale in Louisville, Kentucky, or participating online at the National Belted Galloway Sale in Fryeburg, Maine. We have predominantly purchased animals privately from individual breeders.

My point here is this. Throughout the 23 years we have bought and sold Belted Galloway Cattle, the people we have encountered have been some of the most exemplary people I have ever known. We have not had a bad experience, or had an issue with an animal not being what was marketed. Nor have we ever sold an animal we would not completely stand behind. If we are selling an

animal, it meets the qualifications that we use to retain animals within our herd. Many of the most successful breeders, (those who have cattle with their farm prefixes listed within the foundations of numerous herds throughout the country) have the same standards we employ regarding warrantying cattle.

The Belted Galloway Society's *Breeders Manual* offers sample contracts, guarantees, and more as a resource to protect both the buyer and seller. Those examples apply to embryos, semen, leases, and the sale of live animals. Executive Director Dr. Vic Eggleston also mentioned the need to verify the animal's pedigree with a prospective buyer whether purebred or recorded.

I want to go one step further and state the need for those who sell Belted Galloway cattle to be honest and upfront with the status of all paperwork. It is the seller's responsibility to send and pay all fees for transfers, registrations and leases. Regarding parentage, it is also the seller's responsibility to have DNA work (hair, blood, or semen) submitted prior to marketing semen or embryos. We must continue the legacy of our breed as having the reputation as a honest, close-knit membership who raise and enjoy a historic heritage breed of cattle. I feel it is imperative that we keep it that way. As you may surmise, some very isolated incidents have prompted this message. Let me personally assure you that the Society is 100% committed to preserving and advocating for the breed and the membership.

DNA Fees

As of July 1, 2016, the fee for establishing DNA parentage will be reduced to \$45. This a \$5 reduction from the previous fee. DNA testing may be done using a sample of blood, hair or semen from your animal. Hypotrichosis testing may also be done at the same time for an additional fee of \$20. Please contact Vic Eggleston to generate the paperwork required for testing. The member requesting the test will mail the sample to UC Davis and the results will be forwarded to the member by Eggleston.

Deceased Animals

Please return registration papers to the CLRC when an animal within your herd is deceased. It ensures that the Society database has the most up-to-date information.

- ♦ About bulls ... Before advertising a young male be sure he is well conformed, tracks properly, has good legs and feet, and exhibits good weight gains. We should have data available on his birth weight, 205-day weaning weight, and yearling weight. If he's reached breeding age (around 18 months), it's definitely a plus to have his semen checked for quantity and motility, and uniform scrotal development (two normal sized testicles). Any data available should appear in your advertisement along with his birth date and the names of his sire and dam. It is required that registration numbers be included on bulls advertised for sale in the classifieds.

Application for Registration Changes

A new application for registration form has been developed by The Canadian Livestock Records Corporation for use by the Belted Galloway Society, Inc.

Council approved excluding the belt drawing as part of the registration requirement. Why? The CLRC advised Council that when online electronic applications for registration become a reality, it will be more user friendly for our membership to upload their animal's information without the required belt drawing. The CLRC has recently communicated with the Executive Director's office that they are in the final test stages to accept online registrations.

It is a requirement to document the appropriate information regarding an animal's mismark – if applicable. See below for a visual explanation of the four codes (M1, M2, M3, M4).




