Robert and Sharon Blanchard's Little Everglades Ranch in Dade City, Florida will host the 2011 Belted Galloway Annual Meeting in October. Little Everglades Ranch is 2050 beautiful acres that show a side of Florida that few people get to see and experience! With over 300 acres of lakes and wetlands Little Everglades Ranch is aptly named and these water resources allow LER to have success with their herd of Belted Galloway. The extreme and long lasting heat and humidity in this part of central Florida challenge LER's General Manager Katie Carris with keeping their Belties happy and productive. It is essential that the Belties have a lake in their pasture in which to cool off and the giant live oaks provide plenty of shade.

The Blanchard's brought their first Belted Galloway to LER in the early 1990's after visiting a herd in Maine and falling in love with this unique breed. Today their herd is heavy in Aldermere breeding and they work hard to stay consistent with the lineage they love while also bringing in more modern traits. LER has specific ways of marketing their Belties that are necessary in this southern climate and indeed one of the topics of the Annual Meeting will be about heat stress in cattle. A great learning opportunity for Beltie breeders, especially those in the south!

In addition to the Belted Galloway cattle, Little Everglades has a variety of other areas of production. The commercial cow/calf operation, 200 acres of Tifton 44 hay production (some of which is under pivot), peat mining, Hanoverian sport horses and Thoroughbred race horses keep this working ranch busy. Robert and Sharon Blanchard have also put over 1800 acres of LER in a conservation easement to preserve and protect this land where so many native species flourish and this makes a perfect backdrop for an array of other activities. Some of these activities include equestrian competitions that bring in some of the best carriage drivers from around the world, Pre and State Finals for High School Cross Country, Cyclocross racing, and for the first time this year LER will host an event called Tough Mudder (like Iron Man with teams) which is looking to be a huge event!

October is the month when the weather at LER starts to moderate, the wildlife flourishes, the migratory birds start to arrive, and the Belted Galloway are front and center for the Belted Galloway Annual Meeting!

By-Law Change

During the 2011 Spring Meeting, Council voted to amend the current By-Laws regarding junior membership. The current By-Law state that junior membership ceases on a member's 21st birthday. By implementing the following change, an individual's junior membership will be retained through the calendar year of her/his 21st birthday. We are required to print By-Law Changes twice before a final vote to ensure our membership is informed. During the October meeting, members will be voting on the proposed By-Law change.

Article 1.

Membership

A. There shall be the following classes of membership:

(4) Junior membership. A Junior member shall be an individual under the age of twenty-one (21) and may be assessed annual dues as determined by Council but will have no voting rights. A Junior member shall retain the privileges of junior membership throughout the remainder of the calendar year of his or her (21st) birthday and all rights shall cease after December 31st of that calendar unless converted to a Regular membership.

Junior questions and answers

What is the age requirements of a junior member?

A junior member is a child from birth to 21 years of age. However, a junior member must be 8 years of age in order to show in a Society sanctioned junior show.

We have a child who will be showing cattle, does it matter in whose name the animal appears?

Currently, if the junior wishes to participate in one of the Society's sanctioned junior shows, the child must be a member in good standing of the Belted Galloway Society and animals participating in Society junior shows must be registered/leased in a junior's name.

How long may a junior member participate in Beltie Youth Group activities?

A Beltie Youth Group member who turns 21 years of age will continue to be a Junior Member throughout the remainder of the calendar year after his/her 21st birthday. The Beltie Youth Group allows a person who is 21 on January 1, to continue to participate and show in Beltie Youth Group activities throughout the year. However, she/he will be become a Regular member per the By-Laws of the Belted Galloway Society, Inc. and be assessed regular member dues.

We should have data available on his birth weight, 205-day weaning weight, and yearling weight. If he's reached breeding age (around 18 months), it's definitely a plus to have his semen checked for quantity and motility.

Any data available should appear in your advertisement along with his birth date and the names of his sire and dam. **Further, it is required that registration numbers be included on bulls advertised for sale in the Hotline and newsletter.**






