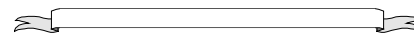

We encourage members to submit ads the last two weeks of the month. **Advertising bulls ...** Before advertising a young male as a breeder we must be sure he is well conformed, tracks properly, has good legs and feet, and exhibits good weight gains. We should have data available on his birth weight, 205-day weaning weight, and yearling weight. If he's reached breeding age (around 18 months), it's definitely a plus to have his semen checked for quantity and motility.

Any data available should appear in your advertisement along with his birth date and the names of his sire and dam. **Further, it is required that registration numbers be included on bulls advertised for sale in the Hotline and newsletter.**

Based on the number of cookies given away, it is estimated there were close to 1500 fairgoers visiting the children's barn to meet Nabisco and enjoy some Oreo cookies and milk.

This was a perfect opportunity to introduce the public to the Belted Galloway breed. Since there are few herds in Minnesota people were really curious about the breed. Jill Askelson enjoyed visiting with the kids and adults. She was especially surprised at how many retirees visited the barn. A lot had raised beef animals prior to retirement and enjoyed

visiting about the breed and sharing their experiences as beef producers.

## By-Law Changes

We are required to print By-Law Changes twice before a final vote to ensure our membership is informed. During the October meeting, members will be voting on proposed By-Law changes. The following changes will finalize the Executive Director position and separate the offices of Secretary and Treasurer.

### Article III. GOVERNMENT

The Society shall be governed by a Council elected by its members and by a President and a Vice President elected by the Council. The Council shall manage the property, affairs and business of the Society. The Council shall have the authority to engage an Executive Director to assist the Council in the management of the property, affairs, and business; however the Executive Director shall not serve in any other office.

### Article IV. COUNCIL

The Council, of which a majority shall constitute a quorum, shall hold its Annual Meeting at such place as may be designated for the Annual General Meeting. At the Annual Meeting of the Council, the Council shall each year elect from its membership a President and a Vice President. In addition, the Council shall elect a Secretary and a Treasurer, or a Secretary/Treasurer. The Secretary and the Treasurer or the Secretary/Treasurer may be a member(s) of the Council.

### Article VI. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR

A. The Council shall designate an Executive Director of the Society. The Executive Director shall be an ex-officio member of the Council with no vote at Council meetings.

B. Qualifications. The Council prefers that the person appointed as Executive Director have experience in a responsible administrative position, strong organizational and communication skills, and a knowledge of cattle industry.

C. Accountability. The Executive Director shall report to the Council, as directed, and to the President of the Council between Council meetings.

D. Compensation. The compensation, terms, and conditions of appointment and services to be rendered to the Society, shall be established by the Council and reviewed annually, or more frequently as deemed appropriate by the Council.

E. Authority and Duties. Specifically, the authority and duties of the Executive Director shall be set and defined by the Council from time to time.

### Article V. OFFICERS

The Secretary shall issue all notices of meetings; and execute all orders of the Council concerning matters pertaining to the office of the Secretary.

The Treasurer shall be the custodian of the cash funds and securities of the Society and shall deposit, invest, and disburse such funds as the Council may determine.

As stated previously, the proposed changes will be voted on by Council at the Annual General Meeting. Proposed changes to By-Laws are posted in the newsletter for two consecutive months. Please forward your questions regarding these changes to President Ron Howard or any member of Council.
