Your Council continues to work hard in preparation for our national show and sale in conjunction with North American International Livestock Exposition this

November in Louisville, Kentucky. We are excited about the 2018 National Belted Galloway show. For the first time, it will pay \$5000 in premiums in the purebred shows. Additionally, the annual meeting for the Belted Galloway Society will be included in the three-day-event beginning November 13, 20018. Please plan to participate. Also new this year is the addition of Mike Jones of West Point, Georgia who will serve as our auctioneer/sales manager for the Belted Galloway Premium Sale. *Consignments are now open!*

Mike Jones has spent his entire working career in the marketing of purebred livestock having served as the eastern fieldman from 1973-1978 with the *Drovers Journal* working with all breeds of cattle and hogs. In 1980, Mike began his auction career being self-employed since that time auctioning and managing sales of all breeds. Mainly known as an Angus auctioneer, Mike also has managed numerous auctions in the Simmental, Charolais, Tarentaise, Belted Galloway, and commercial replacement female sales. In the early to mid-1990's Mike managed and auctioned several Belted Galloway sales including several auctions in the Carolinas, Georgia, the historic Welcome Farms herd setting dispersal in New York and serving as auctioneer at the Fryeburg Sale.

In 1974, the historic International Livestock Show in Chicago, Illinois moved to a new location in Louisville, Kentucky where that prestigious exhibition of superior livestock continued and has grown into the most significant

event of its kind in the world known as the North American International Livestock Exposition. The facilities at the North American are state of the art covering 1.3 million square feet under roof on a property totaling 500 acres. Now in its 45th year; each November this event features National Shows for many species including beef cattle, dairy cattle, sheep, goats, swine, draft horses, riding horses, harness horses plus alpacas and llamas. Breed association annual meetings and auctions are other highlights of the North American while consignors, breeders, and ag enthusiasts from across the nation, Canada and around the world come to exhibit, purchase and learn about top breeds of livestock. The green shavings in the show ring of the climatecontrolled Freedom Hall show arena have become a worldwide icon for the exhibition of quality cattle of all breeds of cattle plus the competition for junior show heifers and steers that always draw a packed house audience.

The North American International Livestock Exposition is a showcase opportunity for breeders to promote their respective breeding programs in full view of fellow breeders. So why bring your best Belted Galloway cattle to Louisville? It is a unique opportunity to put your years of effort in investing, selecting and producing cattle that make up your breeding program in front of hundreds of Belted Galloway cattlemen and cattlemen of other breeds in one setting. 2018 Mandatory Testing Requirements

All bulls born on or after January 1, 2018 are required to be DNA and hypotrichosis tested before registration. Fees for the mandatory DNA and hypotrichosis testing are \$65. The Executive Director's office will generate the paperwork for samples to be submitted to UC Davis.

Bulls born on January 1, 2018 or after, may be registered with the CLRC for \$30 after the DNA and hypotrichosis testing are completed. Council reduced the registration fee to \$30 for all bulls born on January 1, 2018 or after to accommodate the mandatory testing.

The Executive Director's office will notify the breeder with the test results and an authorization for registration.

Bulls born before January 1, 2018 are not required to be DNA or hypotrichosis tested and fees for registration will remain \$50.




About bulls ... Before advertising a young male be sure he is well conformed, tracks properly, has good legs and feet, and exhibits good weight gains. We recommend including data on his birth weight, 205-day weaning weight, and yearling weight. If he's reached breeding age (around 16 months), it's definitely a plus to have his semen checked for quantity and motility, and uniform scrotal development (two normal sized testicles). It is required that registration numbers be included on bulls advertised for sale in the classifieds.


