HOW TO HAIR SAMPLE

By Purdue University Extension

1. Gather supplies (brush, pliers and collection envelopes) and secure animal in a chute/head/gate. Use the brush to clean the tail switch area by removing dirt and other contaminants. Make sure area is dry before collecting hair.
2. Be sure pliers are clean and dry. BGS recommends using a pair of needle nose pliers if available. Place the pliers close to the tail and pull enough hair such that the sample is about the size of a pencil.
3. Be sure to pull the hair directly away from the animal, not at an angle. This will allow the follicle to come out with the hair.
4. Do not cut the hair from the animal as the roots must be present for DNA analysis.
5. Repeat process, 2-3 pulls may be necessary to get enough hair (a minimum of 30 hairs).
6. Visually inspect hairs to ensure follicles are attached. If follicles are not present, discard sample and start over.
7. Place the sample directly into the self-sealing collection envelope and complete the appropriate information on the front of the envelope. Avoid touching the hairs and using plastic bags.
8. Repeat the process for remaining animals. Clean/disinfect pliers and hands between collections to prevent contamination of sample. Animals that are co-enrolled with siblings only need one sample. Just be sure to list all siblings on the envelope.

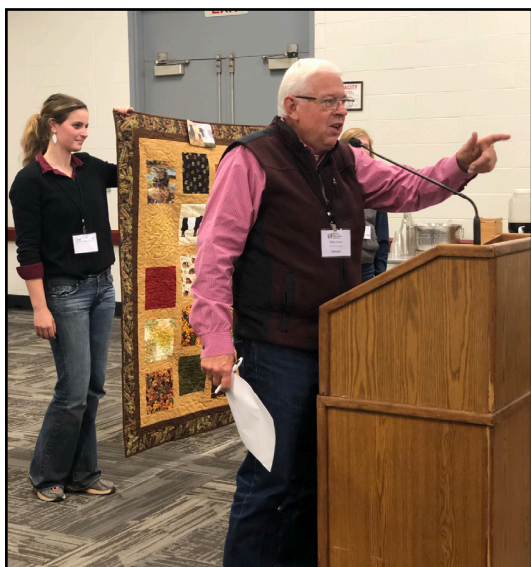

Secretary's Report: Data through September 2019 is as follows: Membership, Regular 786; Junior 88; Associate 5, Life 147. Registration: bulls 143; purebred female 787; Appendix 59. Transfers 748.

Treasurer's Report: Society funds in checking \$31,867, savings \$10,901 and certificate of deposit \$161,011.

Committee Reports

Advertising and Promotions – Jon Bednarski (KY)
Current President of the World Galloway Conference. The World Galloway Conference will be held in Louisville Kentucky, November 17-21, 2020. The Belted Galloway Society will have a dedicated section about the World Galloway Conference in its 2020 Belted Galloway Journal which will be available in July 2020. A request was made from a Galloway breeder to be involved in exhibiting and the sale next year. Jon will be contacting the AGBA President to see if their association would be interested in being involved with the World Galloway Conference in the manner suggested by one of their members. Jon is hoping the conference will attract at least 150 people including 60 from the US. Registration will be online at a dedicated World Galloway Conference website.
