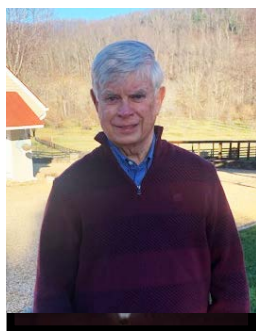

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



President Jack Bagley

April was a very busy month for the Council and the Belted Galloway Society.

We spent a good deal of time interviewing the candidates who applied for the BGS Executive Director position. Each candidate was interviewed via Zoom by the Council, providing us with his/her background and experience, as well as what ideas each would bring to the position. They also

addressed the Society's challenges in an ever changing agricultural and societal environment and how we can overcome them.

After much discussion, the Council selected Greg Hipple (IA) of Sutliff Belties as the new Executive Director of the Society upon Vic Eggleston's (WI) retirement. Greg has been a member of the Society for 25 years, and had served as President from 2016-2017, as well as many Committees on a variety of issues. He is also been a member of GLBGA and SWBGA.

The Council also selected another candidate, Corinna Caron (ME) of Casa Belties to fill a newly created position, Director of Breed Promotion and Member Outreach. The Council wanted to respond to observations by some of its members about the need for more promotion of the breed and more engagement with members, including Juniors, by using social media and digital technology.

I look forward to the new leadership's enthusiasm and ideas for a successful BGS going forward. It has come to my attention that there is a tendency by some of our members and other interested parties to use social media platforms to voice criticism or displeasure with some or all of the Society's decisions rather than address these concerns through normal communication channels, including open forums and phone calls or electronic messages to the BGS leadership. Like any other organization, profit or non profit, there are always some instances where there is not unanimous support by its members, or even all of its governing board, for every decision made by the leadership of an organization. However, for the benefit of the Society's short term functioning and its longer term growth, I urge all of our members who have continuing concerns to support the organizational changes and personnel additions that are underway. I also urge you to work through the governing mechanisms of regional organizations where appropriate to address any concerns for the overall benefit of the Society and its long term sustainability before raising the issues on a national level outside of the Society's ability to consider options or remedies, etc.

The Council also conducted a business meeting while in Fryeburg. This included a report from the Show Committee chaired by Dawson Masters (TX); the Budget and Finance Committee chaired by Terry Etheridge (WI) ; and the Advertising and Promotion Committee chaired by Vice President Sheri Riley (TX). The Sale and Show results are also highlighted in this issue. Attendance at the Sale was outstanding with more than 125 present in person, and many more online. In fact, several purchases were made from members all over the country. Kudos to all those who worked hard to have a successful Sale and Shows.

The Council will have its next meeting in conjunction with the Great Lakes Belted Galloway Regional Roundup Program on June 11 in Columbia City, Indiana.

Budgeting and Finance Committee

Terry Etheridge (WI), Committee Chair

The appointed finance committee has spent a significant amount of time researching the finances and CLRC expenses with the recommendation of increasing the regular membership fees and the lifetime membership fee starting in 2023. To help offset this, increase transaction fees will be waived. Associate membership and junior membership fees remain the same.

This membership fee increase will help offset some of the increases in costs over the last 10 years and transaction fees not paid by members. Just to clarify, the transaction fee is CLRC's payment for performing all transactions. CLRC charges BGS for those transaction fees not paid by members when registering animals or submitting memberships.

BGS strongly recommends members combine as many transactions as possible in their yearly registrations and membership applications to help keep expenses down.




