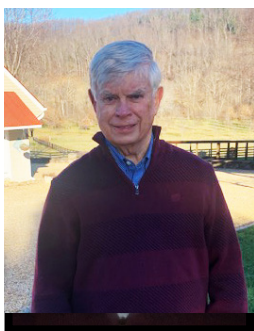

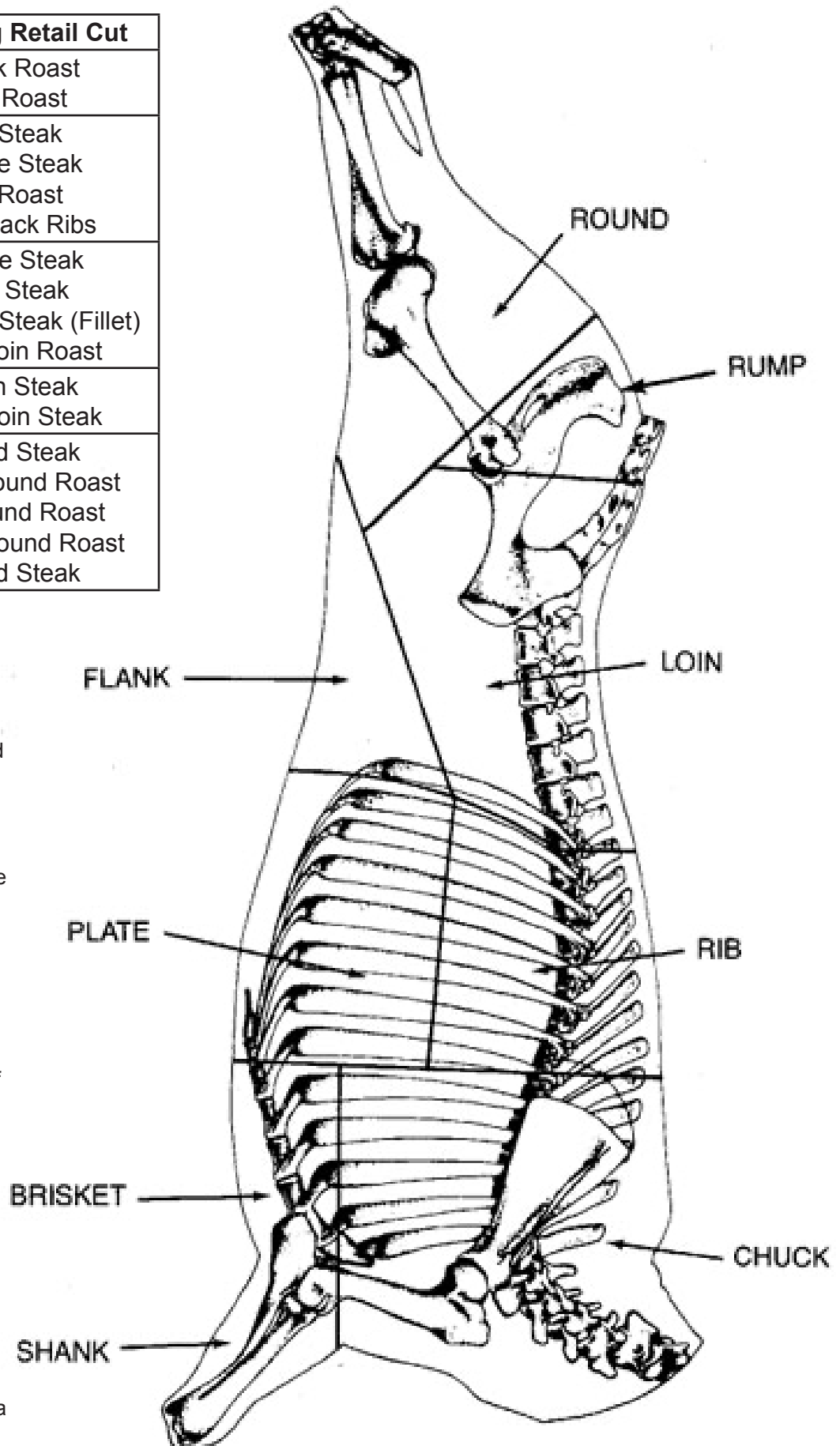

Consumers will be the first to tell you, the meat case can be a confusing place. There are so many beef cuts and options to consider before purchasing the perfect cut i.e. tenderness, recipe, price, etc. Additionally, there may be multiple names for a type of cut between the farmer, the butcher and the consumer.

The table to the right breaks down the wholesale cut that coincides with the common retail cut. Use this table, the below chart and the chart at the end of this newsletter to help guide your beef customers through the tricky process of selecting the perfect beef cut.

Don't forget! Your state's beef checkoff program has a wide variety of resources for FREE to have on hand for your beef customers including beef charts, brochures, etc. Many times, you just have to ask for the materials and they will mail them to you.

The BGS website is also a great resource when looking for Beltie beef specific resources. You can ask Corinna for more information.



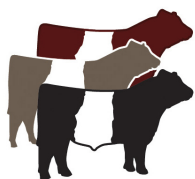

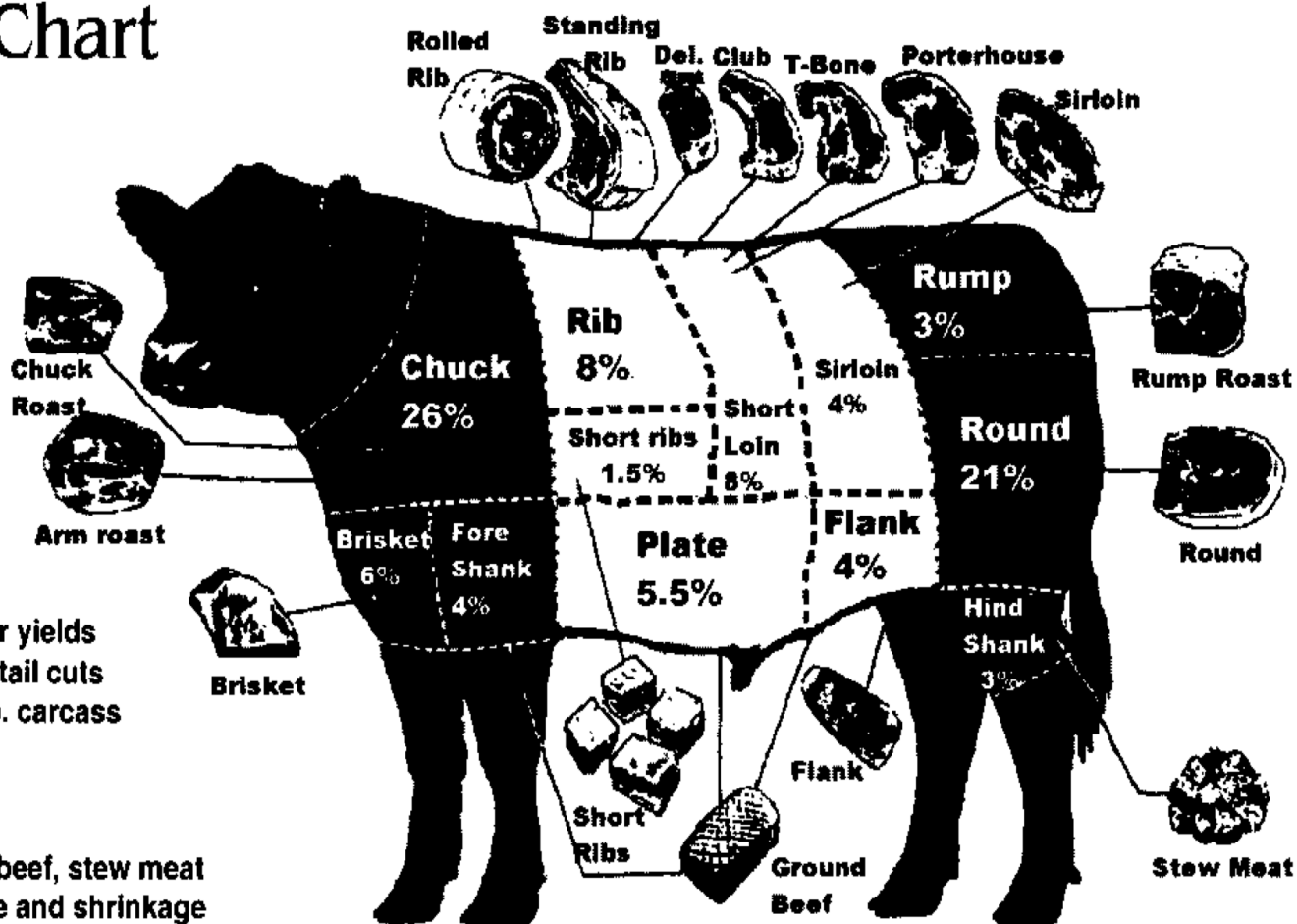
